

### When exactly is the meeting and how long will it last?

- Thursday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016
- The official business meeting will last for 60-90 minutes. Official Webinar start time:
  - BC/Yukon: 5:30PM PST
  - AB/NT/SK: 6:30PM MT
  - Manitoba: 7:30PM CT

### How is the meeting being held?

- The meeting will be held at CBWC churches throughout Western Canada via a webinar conference. For those who don't have internet access a toll-free telephone number will be given to call.

### What number gets dialled?

- Churches will need to register to join the webinar. Once they register online or by mail they will receive an email that allows them to join the webinar. Access will be granted to the email address you provide on the registration form.

### Why are we having an annual meeting?

- A few years ago the CBWC Board decided we would meet face-to-face every second year. A change in CRA rules now means that we are legally required to meet on an annual basis. We have chosen to do so by online webinar. Our hope is that using this technology we can meet together more often and maintain a strong bond across the whole constituency.

### What is the benefit of meeting remotely?

- We are taking advantage of new opportunities and technology available to us which will enable more information about our family to be available to everyone in our denomination.
- This will allow more people to participate in the meetings.
- It is a more cost effective way of meeting.
- It will allow us to have yearly connection between the face-to-face Gathering.
- Denomination information can now be easily accessible to more people.

### What will be discussed at this meeting?

- This will be a meeting focused primarily on Financials.

### Who is being invited to attend the meeting?

- Every church may send one (1) pastor and two (2) elected delegates to vote, plus one delegate for every 50 members above 100 members. All CBWC church members and visitors are welcome as non-voting guests.
- For a legal quorum we need 35 churches represented with 100 delegates present.
