Roof Repairs: Braemar Baptist Church, Edmonton, AB



History

Century II began as a project of the Baptist Men in 1980. It is a program where individuals can pledge support for new initiatives with CBWC churches. Churches wanting to make renovations or upgrades to their facilities can apply to their Regional Minister, who takes recommendations forward to the CBWC's Executive Staff.

Each Century II participant promises to give a minimum of \$20 to each project (up to 4 times a year). 90% of each donation goes to the project, while 10% is used to help cover communication and receipting costs. **To account for inflation over 30 years, please consider increasing your gift above the original \$20, if possible.**

Winter Appeal: Braemar Baptist Church

Braemar Baptist Church is a caring community of 80 members in Edmonton, Alberta. Their facility is well-shared by the Christian community: The Christian Arabic Church of Edmonton (80+ members), and the Edmonton Kachin Baptist Church (40+ members) also meet there.

The facility is being used consistently 4 days a week for various worship and fellowship events, and children's programming, with office staff occupying most of the rest of the time. The facility is also used by outside parties for memorial services, weddings, graduations and baptismal rentals as required.

However, some of this programming has been interrupted by water, as the roof of the building has been leaking.



This flat roof needs to be repaired or replaced soon in order to prevent further damage.

The Need

Several areas including the kitchen, a classroom, and the main hallway have been impacted by water leaks. The flat roof will need to be repaired for a short-term solution, or replaced to solve the issue for a longer period.

The estimate for repairs is \$15,000 – \$25,000, with the lifespan of these repairs being less than 5 years. The other option of replacing the roof is closer to \$150,000.

Braemar's need is immediate so as to not have any further water damage on the property. Please consider generously participating to make this roof replacement happen so Braemar can continue to be a hub for ministry to the nations in Edmonton.
