History

Century II began as a project of the Baptist Men in 1980. It is a program where individuals can pledge support for new initiatives with CBWC churches. Churches wanting to make renovations or upgrades to their facilities can apply to their Regional Minister, who takes recommendations forward to the CBWC's Executive Staff.

Each Century II participant promises to give a minimum of \$20 to each project (up to 4 times a year). 90% of each donation goes to the project, while 10% is used to help cover communication and receipting costs. **To account for inflation over 30 years, please consider increasing your gift above the original \$20, if possible.**

In an effort to keep administration costs to a minimum, you will receive one official income tax receipt for the total contribution made to all projects for the year, sent in February of the next year. Fall Appeal: Bonnie Doon Baptist Church

In April 2017, Bonnie Doon Baptist Church in Edmonton decided to end services. We celebrate the church's rich 104 year history, but also the story of a new plan for continued ministry in this neighbourhood.

The church building resides in the French section of Edmonton. A developing French-speaking Haitian church was in need of a building without the financial resources to obtain one. The CBWC made some necessary repairs so that this new Haitian church could begin to use the space, as well having the option to rent to other users.

This new Haitian church has adopted the constitution of the existing Bonnie Doon Church. On September 8th, 2018, the church brought 52 new members into membership. That night, they appointed deacons and other officers to take over the functions of the church. They also appointed a new pastor.

Now this church on a Sunday morning has vibrant music, numerous kids, and excitement about the way forward. It is a church plant that has not had to take the tedious steps required to gain recognition by the CRA. It is now, in fact, part of the continuing story that is Bonnie Doon Baptist Church.



The Need

There are still many improvements that need to be made for the new Bonnie Doon Baptist Church to thrive in the space.

The building to date has received a new roof, new windows, drainage work and interior paint, but what's needed now is new entry steps and a refurbished kitchen.

The main entry steps are badly failing, and could cost as much as \$15,000 to repair.
