History

Century II began as a project of the Baptist Men in 1980. It is a program where individuals can pledge support for new initiatives with CBWC churches. Churches wanting to make renovations or upgrades to their facilities can apply to their Regional Minister, who takes recommendations forward to the CBWC's Executive Staff.

Each Century II participant promises to give a minimum of \$20 to each project (up to 4 times a year). 90% of each donation goes to the project, while 10% is used to help cover communication and receipting costs. **To account for inflation over 30 years, please consider increasing your gift above the original \$20, if possible.**

Spring Appeal: Berea Baptist Church

Berea Baptist Church held its first service in May, 1950, as a church plant of Olivet Baptist Church in New Westminster. They have been in their current location since its construction in 1978.

Not only is the church used as a place of worship and for Bible studies and a youth program, but also meeting at Berea's facility is a daycare, AA Group, weekly bread distribution and a local clowning group.

The church property also has 30 community garden plots. In the spring of 2011, a Community Garden pilot project was begun to see if Berea Baptist Church could combine caring for God's creation with community building and gardening.

Additional garden plots were added for the 2013 growing season. These garden plots are available to both members of Berea and anyone in the community who is interested.



The Need

The current parking lot is uneven and has pot holes; these make it a challenge to walk on. The parking lot is used by the church, daycare families and other groups that use the building.

The parking lot is also the access route to the community garden area, and the ruts and holes in the lot are a safety hazard to both the congregation and the community they serve.

The initial estimate to repair the lot is \$50,000. Will you help Berea make their property a safe and welcoming ministry location once again?
