

**Position Available: Music Ministry Coordinator**

With that in mind, we are seeking an individual to join our team to assist us in moving our music ministry forward in achieving what we believe to be our God-given mandate in this community.

We are looking for a part time music ministry coordinator that will help assist the Senior Pastor and the Worship Ministry Leader with the overall music responsibilities of White Rock Baptist Church.

**Organizational Relationships:**

Reports to Senior Pastor or the designee (Worship Ministry Leader). Works collaboratively with all Program and Support Staff and Worship Team Members. Must be sensitive to the Spirit of God while relentlessly pursuing new and growing disciples.

**Position Overview:**

- This is a part time position around 20 hours per week, with work-hours negotiable.
- Assist the coordination and organization of all worship team activities at WRBC, including recruiting team members, preparing music, leading rehearsals, and helping with verbal worship leading for Sunday worship services, and special and seasonal services.
- Serve as the lead instrumentalist or support musician for the worship team(s).
- Work with Senior Pastor and the Worship Ministry Leader to plan music in weekly worship services, and at times in consultation with the other pastoral staff and/or worship team members.
- Select appropriate music and prepare all musically related audio/visual requirements to support and assist the service leader.
- Work closely with pastoral team to develop worship themes which support the preaching themes.
- Maintain relationships and communication with members of the Sound and Media Teams as related to rehearsals and services involving worship team(s).
- Build loving relationships in the congregation and community to inspire, motivate, equip and mobilize people to identify and use their God-given gifts, talents, passions, and experience for worship ministry.
- Assist in identifying and encouraging the development of musical gifts for those who are not yet ready to be involved with the worship team(s), but have an obvious passion to do so.
- Utilize a contemporary worship style. The definition of contemporary states "a belonging to or occurring in the present". The definition of contemporary for WRBC is a worship style that connects us to the present and leads us into the future.
- Support the overall mission of WRBC.
- Explore ways to use worship arts and other arts as a means for reaching for Christ those who are unreached or un-churched (children, families and adults) in the area.



**Qualifications for the Position.** We are seeking a person who, above all, knows and loves God, has a vibrant day-to-day relationship with Jesus Christ, and is filled with the Spirit. Specific qualifications include:

- A professed commitment to Jesus Christ and the theology of the evangelical reformed faith, with evidence of ongoing spiritual growth, spiritual leadership and exemplary lifestyle.
- Demonstrates experience and skills in worship ministry and planning, including an understanding of leading worship teams, with instrumental and vocal proficiency preferred, along with a general knowledge of worship technology (such as sound, media, and planning software).
- A passion and energy for connecting with new people and enfolding them into the life of the congregation.
- Strong interpersonal, teamwork, and supervisory skills.
- Self-motivation and organizational skills, requiring minimal supervision.
- Has solid musical skills to develop and lead teams of volunteer musicians and vocalists.
- Post high-school training, including coursework or training in worship, music, Bible and/or ministry is preferred.

This person should be available to work variable part-time hours including daytimes, evenings, weekends and holidays based on ministry needs.
