History

Century II began as a project of the Baptist Men in 1980. It is a program where individuals can pledge support for new initiatives with CBWC churches. Churches wanting to make renovations or upgrades to their facilities can apply to their Regional Minister, who takes recommendations forward to the CBWC's Executive Staff.

Each Century II participant promises to give a minimum of \$20 to each project (up to 4 times a year). 90% of each donation goes to the project, while 10% is used to help cover communication and receipting costs. **To account for inflation over 30 years, please consider increasing your gift above the original \$20, if possible.**

In an effort to keep administration costs to a minimum, you will receive one official income tax receipt for the total contribution made to all projects for the year, sent in February of the next year. Summer Appeal: Brownfield Baptist Church

At over 100 years old, Brownfield Baptist Church has been influencing rural Alberta for a long time.
