



The YLT (Youth Leadership Team) exists to further the kingdom building work among adolescents in CBWC (Canadian Baptists of Western Canada) churches and their communities.

The YLT is comprised of the CBWC Director of Next Generation Ministries and 10 CBWC regional youth/young adult workers representing Vancouver Island, Vancouver, Fraser Valley, Okanagan, Northern BC/Yukon, Northern Alberta/Northwest Territories, Central Alberta, Southern Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba.

Position: YLT Regional Representative

- Must be serving actively among youth within a CBWC church or ministry
- Requires 1-2 hours per week and more when attending meetings/conferences
- Remuneration: \$0.00 paid on days ending in Y
- Accountable to the Director of Next Generation Ministries

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Support youth/young adult workers within your region
 - a. Pray for them
 - b. Be available
 - c. Be in regular contact
 - d. Organize 1-2 gatherings of regional youth/young adult workers annually
 - i. Money is available to pay for these gatherings (or supplement the cost)
 - e. Disseminate relevant information and resources
2. Event planning support
 - a. SERVE, Potential Impact, Youth Rallies, Ministry Training, Etc.
3. Attend YLT meetings (and conferences)
 - a. Between 4-6 annually, with at least one being in person and the rest via phone/video call
 - i. Semi-regular opportunities to attend training conferences will also be offered.
4. Support the Director of Next Generation Ministries
 - a. Provide contact info of new youth/young adult workers in your region
 - b. Partner in strategizing, developing and implementing new youth/young adult initiatives within the CBWC
 - c. Be open to additional requests from the Director of Next Generation Ministries
