Job Title: Children's and Youth Worker
Reports to: Lead Pastor/Church Board
Job Type: Canada Summer Jobs Position: 16 Weeks – 35 hours/week

We are open to hiring anyone who is looking at a career in the Ministry or working with youth and children, must be under the age of 30, preference will be given to those actively pursuing a degree or employment in religious ministry. The position may lead to a position following the 16 weeks.

Purpose

The Children's and Youth Worker will work together with Charlie Lake Community Church to build relationships with local children and youth, disciple them through personal relationships, provide appropriate teaching through various church programs, with a variety of activities which will enable children/youth to experience salvation, become true disciples of Christ, develop emotional stability and realize healthy social interaction with all age groups.

Structures of accountability:

- Accountable to the Lead Pastor to submit plans and report on the current month's activities including financial expenditures.
- Accountable to the Lead Pastor for the general flow of day-to-day activities, weekly meetings for review and to develop future programming.
- Keep scheduled hours so people know when they can be contacted.
- If direction is necessary, the Lead Pastor will give guidance in a loving manner, maintaining confidentiality.

Tasks and Responsibilities: (Job tasks and responsibilities will be somewhat flexible due to COVID guidelines)

- Weekly Mentoring with the Lead Pastor, as well as some job shadowing.
- Work with the other staff of the church on a daily basis to facilitate the programs required, and to make sure they are following the COVID protocols.
- Plan, organize and run youth events.
- Plan and organize Backyard Bible Camps throughout the summer.
- Will need to be able to communicate both in person and through digital media.
- Be able to attend the worship services on Sundays and help where needed.
- A vehicle will be required to get to different programs and events.

General Requirements

The Children's and Youth Worker will demonstrate a Christ-like life to those he/she is ministering to as well as those in the community. It is this example of Christ that will be the greatest influence on the lives of those around them. The lifestyle of the worker will follow those found in 1Timothy 3 and Titus 1:5-9.
