



Voting Instructions for Delegates for Online Assembly



The Online Assembly will be a view-only webinar via Zoom Webinar with interactive poll and chat options during the session. On the morning of May 16, 2024, you will receive instructions and a link to the webinar via the email provided during the registration process. The webinar will go live at 5:00pm PST and will officially start at 5:30pm PST. Please ensure high speed internet connectivity and audio capability and note the instructions below for optimum voting experience. Use the chat function within the Zoom platform for tech support as needed.

The zoom web browser client will download automatically when you start or join your first Zoom meeting, and is also available in the [Appstore](#) or for manual download [HERE](#) (click on "Zoom Client for Meetings").

In the voting process we will be requesting people to move and second motions. Please use the chat function to type in your name and church name and join in the competition to beat another church to the punch.

**** please turn off your internet browsers pop-up-blocker prior to logging in to the meeting so that you can view the text of the poll and take part in voting.**

Individuals:



When it comes time to vote, you will see a real-time poll, with the text of the motion that is being voted on, up on the screen.

- Select your response of yes, no, or abstain
- Press "SUBMIT" to give us a real-time result of the poll.
- Once we have received all the votes, you will see a report on your screen stating the final results, and the President will verbally declare the vote as carried if applicable.
- Please note that there will be a brief pause of spoken word after each poll is put on the screen as it takes some time to gather in all the votes. Thank you in advance for your patience.

Groups:



When it comes time to vote, you will see a real-time poll, with the text of the motion that is being voted on, up on the screen.

- Please use the chat function for one person from your group to send in the count of yes/no/abstain **and** your church name.
- Once we have received all the votes, you will see a report on your screen stating the final results and the President will verbally declare the vote as carried if applicable.
- Please note that there will be a brief pause of spoken word after each poll is put on the screen as it takes some time to gather in all the votes. Thank you in advance for your patience.
