Position Overview:

Responsibilities include collaborating with the Pastor of Youth & Young Adults to develop and execute a strategic plan which aligns with the pillars of youth ministry as well as New Life's mission, vision and values; planning, organizing and executing all youth ministry nights; and collaborating with the Director of KidZone in the House to plan and organize Sunday morning Pre-Teen classes.

Responsibilities:

Administration

- Assist Pastor of Youth & Young Adults in developing a strategic plan with quarterly targets that align with the pillars of youth ministry and New Life's One Page Strategic Plan
- Participate in staff meetings and staff development opportunities
- Prepare and disseminate communications to youth and parents

Spiritual Care

- Collaborate with Pastor of Youth & Young Adults in spiritual development of students in Deeper
- Collaborate with the Pastor of Youth & Young adults to provide oversight of volunteer youth leaders
 - o Provide support and resources as required
 - Quarterly one-on-one development meetings

Ministry Work

- Collaborate with Pastor of Youth & Young Adults to plan, organize and execute (including clean-up) all
 youth ministry nights
 - o Provide teaching as directed by the Pastor of Youth & Young Adults
 - o Plan games
 - o Coordinate any set-up or clean-up requirements
 - Assign small groups to leaders
- Collaborate with the Director of KidZone in the House to plan and organize Sunday morning Pre-Teen classes
 - Scheduling and communicating with volunteers
 - o Preparing and distributing curriculum to volunteers
 - o Generally supporting and training volunteers in their role
